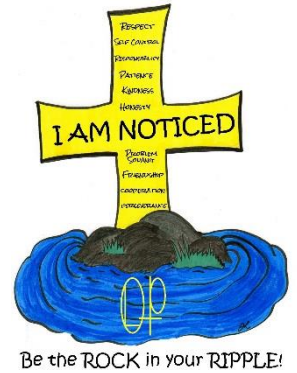
SCHOOL BUSINESS:

END OF THE YEAR REMINDERS: Please remember that all school accounts must be current in order for students to receive their final report card on May 23. Registration for next year is also considered incomplete until these obligations are met.

- **Tuition**—Tuition must be paid in full for this school year. Online payments may be made at www.olpls.org/online-giving or you may pay by check.
- **Library loans/fees**—All library books must be returned and fees paid.
- **Lunch accounts**—Please check your student balance. All negative balances must be paid by the end of the school year.
- **ACED accounts** – Full Time and Full Time Plus Accounts need to be paid in full to receive report cards. Final invoices for May have been sent. Part Time accounts must be paid through their April Care Invoices in order to receive report cards. Part Time May Care Invoices will be sent between **May 23 – 31**.

HEALTH ROOM REMINDERS: The health room will be sending all student medications home on the last day of school – **Wednesday, May 23**. If your student will not be here on that day, please contact the health room nurses to make other arrangements to pick up those medicines. No medicines will be kept at school over the summer. All medicines left after the last day of school will be disposed of. There are many medicines in the health room (daily meds/inhalers/epi-pens/prn meds) – some have never been used this school year. If you do not know if your student has medications in the health room, please call 251-1123 or 251-1130 or send an email to nurses@olpls.org and we can check for you.
