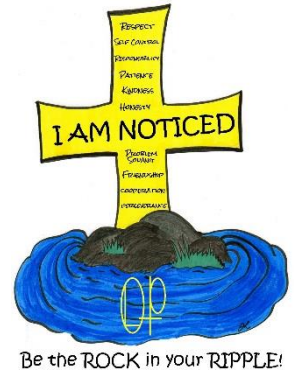

SCHOOL BUSINESS:

END OF THE YEAR REMINDERS: Please remember that all school accounts must be current in order for students to receive their final report card on May 23. Registration for next year is also considered incomplete until these obligations are met.

- **Tuition**—Tuition must be paid in full for this school year. Online payments may be made at www.olpls.org/online-giving or you may pay by check.
- **Library loans/fees**—All library books are due on **Friday, May 18**.
- **Lunch accounts**—Please check your student balance and make sure it is paid. Emails are sent weekly to those students who have a balance of -\$10 or less, but all negative balances must be paid by the end of the school year.
- **ACED accounts** – Full Time and Full Time Plus Accounts need to be paid in full to receive report cards. Final invoices for May have been sent. Part Time accounts must be paid through their April Care Invoices in order to receive report cards. Part Time May Care Invoices will be sent between **May 23 – 31**.

IOWA ASSESSMENT SCORES: The results are in! Parents may pick up student Iowa Test scores at the front office. All remaining results will be sent home with final grade cards **May 23**.

DISMISSAL PARKING REMINDER: Curbside parking north of the church at afternoon dismissal is reserved for Auction winners who purchased these spots. Please do not park in these designated places.
